Groups Sermon Guide

John 19:28–30

- Remember that groups are a place to practice what is preached.
- Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- Ask a group member to read **John 19:28–30** out loud.
- Are there particular promises of God that you struggle to believe are true for you? Can you articulate why you struggle to believe them?
- In what area of your life with Him are you believing that God loves the future version of you and is either frustrated or simply tolerating you today?
- Pray over one another in these areas of struggle and unbelief. Use Ephesians 3:14–20 as a guide for your prayer.

Weekly Questions for One Another

- What is God saying to you in this Word, in the sermon, and in your walk with Him this week?
- What is God telling you to do? How can we as a Group be part of giving you courage to obey?
- How can we pray for you? For your neighbors?
