- **Kids Eat Free Summer Program**

Purchase and pack 400 bags and then deliver to CCA on a designated date/time. Weekend food packs are delivered along with a VBS-style activity pack to share the love of Christ with children. Eleven weeks will be available to choose from; each week has a theme and Bible verse to base purchases of fun activities for elementary-aged children.

ONGOING OPPORTUNITIES

- **Food Pantry Warehouse**

Pantry Assistants

2-hour shifts, Monday–Thursday, 8 a.m. – 8:30 p.m. and Fridays, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. Volunteers unload and organize food products; they must be able to work in a fast-paced setting, lift 10–15 pounds, squat, and bend. Children ages 12–15 must be accompanied by a responsible adult (18 years or older).

Bread Runner

Once per week, 8 a.m. – 9 a.m. or 10 a.m. – 11 a.m.

Individuals or teams of two pick up donated bread and pastries from one local grocery store and deliver to the food pantry.

Denton Mobile Pantry

Once per week, Tuesdays

CCA partners with a Denton church and North Texas Food Bank to operate a mobile food pantry. They occasionally need a few more volunteers during the day, depending on the week's volunteer signups.
