



An Hour of Prayer for Consecrate

For the next hour, use this guide as you pray.

1. Praise and Worship

"Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!" **Psalm 95:2**

Enter His presence with thanksgiving and joyful songs. Sing songs of praise you know by heart, like "Holy, Holy, Holy" or "Amazing Grace."

5. The Living Sacrifice

Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God... **Romans 12:1**

Pray for personal and corporate re-dedication; being "set apart" for God. Offer your own talents and energy specifically for the success of Consecrate.

9. Spiritual Authority

For although we live in the flesh, we do not wage war according to the flesh, since the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but are powerful through God for the demolition of strongholds.

2 Corinthians 10:3-4

Rebuke distractions and spiritual opposition. Invite the "weight" of God's glory to rest on the building.

2. Quiet Your Heart

"Stop fighting, and know that I am God, exalted among the nations, exalted on the earth." **Psalm 46:10**

Create space for God's activity and rest in His company. Pray for a calm mind and no distracting thoughts; your stillness is your prayer.

6. Anointing for Leaders

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of the herald, who proclaims peace, who brings news of good things..." **Isaiah 52:7a**

Pray for the speakers and leaders involved in the event by name: **Jon Tyson, Jennie Allen, Luke LeFevre, Josh Patterson, Matt Chandler, Grant McCurdy, and Will Raies**. Pray specifically for anointing and clarity of message.

10. Thanksgiving & Sealing

"Now to him who is able to do above and beyond all that we ask or think according to the power that works in us..." **Ephesians 3:20**

Rejoice in the lives that will be changed and the miracles to come. Seal these prayers in the name of Jesus and celebrate God's goodness with gratitude.

3. Repentance & Confession

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. **1 John 1:9**

Ask God to search your heart and the hearts of the people of The Village Church. Confess any pride, division, or lukewarmness that has weighed you down.

7. Preparing the Harvest

"Still other seed fell on good ground and produced fruit: some a hundred, some sixty, and some thirty times what was sown." **Matthew 13:8**

Pray that the "soil" of our hearts are ready to receive the Word and produce fruit. Pray that every person attending Consecrate experiences a permanent shift in their walk with God.

4. Purifying the Vessel

"Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? The one who has clean hands and a pure heart..." **Psalm 24:3-4**

Pray for "clean hands and a pure heart" for every person involved in the event. Pray for the cleansing of the church as a vessel for God's glory.

8. Logistics & Protection

Devote yourselves to prayer; stay alert in it with thanksgiving. **Colossians 4:2**

Pray for the practical details and safety of the gathering. Pray for good weather and safe travel conditions, for technical elements to be in working order, and for a "hedge of protection" around the church property and people in attendance.
