## Wholly Dependent on God



It is a joy to tell stories of how TVC is stewarding the gifts we've been given, enabling us to generously resource others and to bless as we have been blessed.

More than we need financial support, we long to see disciples of Jesus with hearts fully surrendered to Him, giving sacrificially of their time, their energy, their passion, and their money. Paul says this in Philippians 4:17: "Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that increases to your credit." We pray that the Holy Spirit would continually point your gaze to Jesus, that you would "know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, [and] that you may be filled with all the fullness of God" (Ephesians 3:19). Out of the overflow of that fullness, we ask that you prayerfully consider how you will give to the work of ministry at TVC.

Giving To Impact the World



In 2022, we received **\$13.9M** in contributions which is consistent with 2021. Here is how some of those funds were stewarded in 2022:

**\$20K** restorative blessing toward all of our goers on the field. Established a **\$225K** fund with Reliant for supporting minority church planters. **\$108K** has been distributed to date.

**\$100K** to secure land for long-term ministry in an unreached part of the world.

Also, a generous donor donated their vehicle to TVC to be used by church planters and furloughed missionaries.

We are a welcoming home to thousands of people seeking Jesus Christ and growing in the grace of the gospel. With all our efforts wholly dependent on God, we **make disciples** across all ages; every stage of life has a portion in the church. We celebrate 300 baptisms every year. We have **generously resourced** millions of people across the globe as we share the gifts that God has entrusted to us. **Every day, in** all spaces, through each season of life, we are building beyond ourselves, living the greater story together, and creating a kingdom legacy for generations to come.
