At The Village Church, we define a disciple as a follower of Jesus who continually surrenders all of life to God's good design for identity, belonging, and purpose.

A follower of Jesus...

Following Jesus means to see Jesus for who He is, believe what He says is true, and to order your life around His life, work, and message—God's movement toward humanity to restore life with Him.

...who continually surrenders all of life to God's good design...

To order your life around God's good design requires the act of surrendering in all of our life for all of our life. Becoming who God created us to be is complete in its scope and is lifelong in process. Following Jesus is neither linear nor simple; it is a life of surrendering to our Creator when we are prone to trust ourselves first.

...for identity, belonging, and purpose.

Surrendering to our Creator and trusting Him over ourselves allows us to embrace His good design for who we are and who we should become. This requires us to continuously look to Him as we grow in knowledge of God and self, in community, with a shared mission and distinct purpose.

This catalog provides you with all of our events and programs planned for the next year. As you consider ways to get involved at The Village Church, use the following questions to help you discern the right programs and environments that will help you grow in wisdom and character as you pursue God's good design for identity, belonging, and purpose.
